
NEW TNC MECHANISMS

- ▶ The period of applying provisional measures ends on March 31, 2019 according to NC BAL. As of **April 1, 2019**, **imbalance tolerances are not applied** at any entry and exit points from the transmission system
- ▶ In accordance with the provisions of the applicable TNC (point 15.8), mechanisms that should prevent differences between operative and settlement allocations transferred by DSOs, end users and Interoperating System Operator (ISO) will enter into force on May 1, 2019 fee for non-compliance of operative data in relation to the settlement data



AUCTION CALENDAR 2019

- ► Auctions of annual products (2019/2020):
 - Firm capacity July 1
 - Interruptible capacity July 15
- ► Auctions of quarterly products (2018/2019):
 - Firm capacity May 6, August 5
 - ► Interruptible capacity March 4, June 3, September 2
- ► Auctions of monthly products (2018/2019):
 - ► Firm capacity 3rd Monday of a month
 - Interruptible capacity 4th Tuesday of a month
- Auctions of daily products:
 - Firm capacity every day at 4:30 P.M.
 - Interruptible capacity every day at 5:30 P.M.
- ► Intra-day product auctions:
 - Firm capacity every hour

EU REGULATIONS



Gas Directive:

- Amendment to the Gas Directive approved by COREPER
- Application of European law to gas pipelines from third countries
- ▶ Entry into force of the amendment and the implementation of new provisions



SoS Regulation:

- ▶ Implementation of the Regulation regional risk analysis (Belorussian and Ukrainian corridor), solidarity mechanism
- Security of supply after 2020 (contract issues)



INTERCONNECTIONS PROJECTS

INTERCONNECTOR POLAND-SLOVAKIA (FID in 2018)

- ▶ Capacity: 4.7 bcm/year towards SK, 5.7 bcm/year towards PL
- Status: The engineering stage has been already completed, preparations are underway to start the implementation stage, and the procedure for selecting the contractor for construction works has been launched. The construction of the gas pipeline is already underway on the Slovak side.

INTERCONNECTOR POLAND-LITHUANIA (FID in 2018)

- ▶ Capacity: 2.4 bcm/year towards LT, 1.9 bcm/year towards PL
- Status: Design works are underway, construction permits have already been obtained for the northern section, design works for the southern section are continued. GAZ-SYSTEM conducts activities aimed at starting the implementation stage. Proceedings are underway on the Lithuanian side to select the contractor for construction works.

INTERCONNECTOR POLAND-UKRAINE


- Capacity: 5 bcm/year towards UA, 5 bcm/year towards PL
- **Status:** There are talks between project partners to make investment decisions on the implementation of the interconnector.

INTERCONNECTOR POLAND-CZECH REPUBLIC

- Capacity: 5 bcm/year towards CZ, 6.5 bcm/year towards PL
- **Status:** There are talks between project partners to make investment decisions on the implementation of the interconnector.

BALTIC PIPE (ID in 2018)

- Capacity: 10 bcm/year towards PL, 3 bcm/year towards DK
- Status: All project elements are being designed, both in Poland and in Denmark.





INCREMENTAL PROJECT



Incremental capacity project for the border of the Poland-GASPOOL market area (Incremental Project)

- according to the CAM NC Regulation
- based on the results of a non-binding assessment of market demand as part of the process of achieving the 2017 incremental capacity
- on the interconnection point (IP) GCP GAZ-SYSTEM/ONTRAS
- ► X 2018 GAZ-SYSTEM/ONTRAS → submission of draft proposals for approval by the President of ERO/BNetzA respectively
- ▶ IV 2019 expected to obtain coordinated decisions of the President of ERO and BNetzA on the approval of the project
- V 2019 publication of information on the project and rules for participation and gaining access to incremental capacity in the binding allocation stage
- July 2019 incremental capacity auction at the GCP GAZ-SYSTEM/ONTRAS point (towards Germany)

Direction: PL → GASPOL

Exit Poland - 910 767 kWh/h/y

Entry Gaspol - 2 025 676 kWh/h/y

- Agreement on the Development Plan with the President of ERO
- Analysis and implementation of ERO's comments to the National Ten-Year Network Development Plan (TYNDP)
