

REMIT - REGULATION ON WHOLESALE ENERGY MARKET INTEGRITY AND TRANSPARENCY

OBJECTIVES OF REMIT



TRANSPARENCY

Obligation to disclose inside information



INTEGRITY

Prohibition of market manipulation and abuse



MONITORING

Legal framework for wholesale energy market monitoring




COOPERATION

Close cooperation and coordination of market supervision between ACER and NRAs



Obligation to disclose inside information







WORDING OF THE PROHIBITION

- using inside information by acquiring or disposing of, or by trying to acquire or dispose of, for their own account or for the account of a third party, either directly or indirectly, wholesale energy products to which that information relates;
- disclosing that information to any other person unless such disclosure is made in the normal course of the exercise of their employment, profession or duties;
- recommending or inducing another person, on the basis of inside information, to acquire or dispose of wholesale energy products to which that information relates.



Prohibition of market manipulation or manipulation attempt



WHAT IS MARKET MANIPULATION (Article 2(2) REMIT)


Entering into any transaction or issuing any order to trade in wholesale energy products which:

- gives, or is likely to give, false or misleading signals as to the supply of, demand for, or price of wholesale energy products;
- secures or attempts to secure, by a person, or persons acting in collaboration, the price of one or several wholesale energy
 products at an artificial level (unless the reasons for doing so are legitimate and that transaction or order to trade
 conforms to accepted market practices on the wholesale energy market concerned)
- employs or attempts to employ a fictitious device or any other form of deception or contrivance which gives, or is likely to give, false or misleading signals regarding the supply of, demand for, or price of wholesale energy products;
- disseminating information through the media, including the internet, or by any other means, which gives, or is likely to give, false or misleading signals as to the supply of, demand for, or price of wholesale energy products

Obligations of Persons Professionally Arranging Transactions – PPATs



PERSON

 The entity must be a legal or natural person

PROFESSIONALLY

 Engagement in a specific activity as part of a normal and regular paid activity

ARRANGING TRANSACTIONS

• Undertake activities that aim to: enable/support third parties in a way that leads to transactions (the direct effect is to conclude transactions); facilitate transactions on the wholesale energy market.

OBLIGATIONS OF PPATS



MARKET MONITORING

Establishing and maintaining effective mechanisms and procedures to identify breaches of Article 3 or Article 5



REPORTING OF SUSPECTED REMIT BREACHES

Reporting reasonable suspicions of REMIT breaches to NRAs (by sending STRs)



PENALTIES FOR REMIT INFRINGEMENTS /1

PENALTIES UNDER THE ENERGY LAW

TYPE OF BREACH (Article 57a-57b(1) of the Energy Law)	CRIMINAL SANCTION FOR COMMITTED OFFENCE
Market manipulation	 a fine of up to 2,500 daily rates, penalty of restriction of liberty or deprivation of liberty from 3 months to 5 years
Engaging in collusion with another person for the purpose of market manipulation	 a fine of up to 1000 daily rates
Using inside information to acquire or dispose of (or attempt to) energy products ()	 a fine of up to 2,500 daily rates, penalty of restriction of liberty or deprivation of liberty from 3 months to 5 years



PENALTIES FOR REMIT INFRINGEMENTS /2

PENALTIES UNDER THE ENERGY LAW

TYPE OF BREACH (Article 57b(2) of the Energy Law)	CRIMINAL SANCTION FOR COMMITTED OFFENCE
Using inside information by members of administrative bodies, management boards, supervisory boards and employees with access to such information	 a fine of up to 2,500 daily rates, penalty of restriction of liberty or deprivation of liberty from 6 months to 8 years
Disclosure of inside information to any other person	 a fine of up to 1000 daily rates, penalty of restriction of liberty or deprivation of liberty for up to 3 years
Recommending or inducing another person, on the basis of inside information, to acquire or dispose of wholesale energy products	 a fine of up to 1000 daily rates, penalty of restriction of liberty or deprivation of liberty for up to 3 years



PENALTIES FOR REMIT INFRINGEMENTS /3

PENALTIES UNDER THE ENERGY LAW

TYPE OF BREACH (Article 57f of the Energy Law)	CRIMINAL SANCTION FOR COMMITTED OFFENCE
Failure of a PPAT to report to the President of the Energy Regulatory Office, despite the obligation under Article 15 of REMIT	 fine the penalty of restriction or deprivation of liberty for up to 3 years
